**ALL International students that receive I-20s or student visas from St. Mary's Preparatory will be charged a \$3,000.00 fee. The \$3,000.00 fee covers account management, parent fees, work hours and SEVIS maintenance. ALL I-20 students must be enrolled as International Students which means they are 7-day boarders and must pay the \$3,000.00 fee for a total of \$25,750.00.**

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS (except students from China, Taiwan, or Hong Kong – Read Box Below):  
\$25,750.00

This covers tuition, room and board (books not included).

**ALL International Students that come from China, Taiwan, or Hong Kong must be processed and admitted through The Three W Canada International Agency. The tuition rate for these Chinese students receiving the I-20 or F1 student visa from St. Mary's Preparatory is \$39,750.00 for tuition, and room and board. We provide a very high level of administrative service, staffing, and language liaisons for the families of these students thus causing the tuition and fee rate to be substantially higher than other International Students.**

In addition to tuition and fees, all students will need to purchase books and some supplies from the bookstore. Estimated cost for books is between \$400.00 and \$600.00 per Academic Year.

All families must also purchase \$225.00 in raffle tickets at the start of the year for the Country Fair. Those tickets may be sold or bought by the family. Additional fees and costs may be incurred throughout the year.

Families will receive a \$1000.00 "Family / Brothers" discount for each student enrolled after the first student.

## **TUITION PAYMENT PLANS**

**(REVISED: JANUARY 2009)**

### **1. PAYMENT IN FULL – CASH, CHECK, MONEY ORDER, OR CREDIT CARD**

Payment in full must be completed by September 15. Any family that pays in full by August 15 is granted a \$100.00 discount off the price of tuition. Any family with more than one student enrolled at the same time will receive a \$1,000.00 discount on each student after the first. All returning families, whether they choose to pay in full or make monthly payments, are asked to make a \$1,000.00 Registration Deposit towards tuition by April 5, 2010. This deposit is non-refundable after June 15.

### **2. F.A.C.T.S. AUTOMATIC TUITION PAYMENT PLAN**

St. Mary's has contracted with the F.A.C.T.S. Tuition management company to provide for automatic monthly deductions from a specified bank account, or charges to a specified credit card. Payment in full must be completed by February 1. The earlier payment is begun, the smaller the monthly installments will be. A large down payment may be made to reduce the monthly cost. All families wishing to make payment through the F.A.C.T.S. program are asked to make a \$1,000.00 Registration Deposit towards tuition within one month after acceptance. This deposit is non-refundable after June 15. Application forms and information pamphlets are available in the school office.

**No student will be allowed to begin taking classes without submitting the properly completed Registration and Health Forms and acceptance of one of the payment plans by the responsible parent.**

## **FINANCIAL AID**

- **St. Mary's Preparatory offers financial aid based on need, only.**
- Partial Academic Scholarships are determined by a student's score on the High School Placement Test.
- Partial Matching Scholarships may also be available with proof of the confirmation letters from other Archdiocesan schools.
- Financial aid is awarded on a first come, first serve basis. Applying early greatly increases the chance of receiving an award.
- Applications may be requested through the school office. These forms become available in late February and may be requested after a student has been accepted.
- St. Mary's Preparatory may not honor requests made after May 15.
- Financial aid does not cover books, school supplies, or fees.
- The balance owed must be resolved through one of the payment plans outlined above.
